The Following Items May Not Be Disposed of in the Compactor

- Hazardous Wastes - defined by Federal and State regulations (prohibited)
- Special Wastes - defined by Maine State Solid Waste regulations (prohibited)
- Explosives (prohibited)
- Pathological and Biological Wastes (prohibited)
- Ashes (prohibited)
- Foundry Sand (prohibited)
- Sanitary Sewage (prohibited)
- All Human and Significant Quantities of Animal Remains
- Bicycles (metal pile, stripped of tires and plastics)
- Appliances (metal pile, may be a fee)
- Metal Shopping Carts (metal pile)
- Cable, Metal Wire and Coils (metal pile)
- Motor Vehicles and parts of motor vehicles (prohibited)
- Free Liquids
- Solid or Dissolved Materials in Domestic Sewage
- Common Water Pollutants
- Non-burnable Construction Material or Demolition Debris (see attendant)
- Solid Waste having a heating value of more than 7,000 BTUs per pound
- Wooden Pallets
- Items larger than 3 feet in any dimension
- Brush and Tree Stumps
- Lead Acid Batteries (see attendant)
- Smoke Detectors
- Carbon Monoxide Detectors
